I. Situation Overview

On 24 September 2024 at around 4:15 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Himosonan, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of two (2) families or 13 persons are affected in Brgy. Himos-onan, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **two (2) families** or **13 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Himos-onan, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P19,389.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
