### I. Situation Overview

On 24 September 2024 at around 4:15 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Himos-onan, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte.

A total of **two (2) families** or **13 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Himos-onan, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte** (see Annex A).

#### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **two (2) families** or **13 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Himos-onan, Saint Bernard, Southern Leyte** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱19,389.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
