I. Situation Overview

On 01 November 2024 at around 7:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Labasan St., Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 9:00 AM.

A total of three (3) families or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are three (3) or five (5) persons currently taking temporary shelter in Kayang Extension Day Care Center in Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱41,268.54 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱31,268.54 from DSWD and ₱10,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
