

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Linao, Ormoc City, Leyte as of 27 November 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 16 November 2024 at around 1:21 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Linao, Ormoc City, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 1:58 PM.

A total of **15 families** or **57 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Linao, Ormoc City, Leyte** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **15 families** or **57 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Brgy. Linao Covered Court** in **Ormoc City, Leyte** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Linao, Ormoc City, Leyte** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱107,910.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
