I. Situation Overview

On 16 November 2024, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Maligaya, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

A total of 11 families or 20 persons are affected in Brgy. Maligaya, Puerto Princesa, Palawan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are 11 families or 20 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Maligaya, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P32,323.35** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
