I. Situation Overview

On 19 November 2024 at around 6:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Kangkungan St., Brgy. Manggahan, Pasig City. The fire was declared out at around 9:07 PM.

A total of **208 families** or **983 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Manggahan, Pasig City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **208 families** or **983 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Manggahan, Pasig City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **52 houses** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Manggahan, Pasig City** (see Annex C).
