I. Situation Overview

On 21 November 2024 at around 12:12 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Pedro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 2:05 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **57 families** or **240 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Pedro**, **Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **57 families** or **240 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Molo 1 Elementary School** in **Brgy. San Pedro, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 48 houses were damaged; of which, 46 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. San Pedro, Iloilo City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P239,520.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
