



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Vicente, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar

as of 06 November 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 October 2024 at around 10:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Vicente, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar. The fire was declared out at around 11:00 AM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VIII provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of affected family and individuals. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VIII

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. San Vicente, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. San Vicente, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱9,130.80 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected family (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱71.62 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 108,927 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 17,167 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City, and 91,760 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 48,843 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱262.84 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.
