I. Situation Overview

On 21 November 2024 at around 7:32 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Western Bicutan, Taguig City. The fire was declared out at around 9:04 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **26 families** or **84 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Western Bicutan, Taguig City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **26 families** or **84 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Multipurpose Hall Western Bicutan** in **Brgy. Western Bicutan**, **Taguig City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **nine (9) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Western Bicutan, Taguig City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱338,900.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱78,900.00 from DSWD and ₱260,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
