

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Pasay City

as of 09 November 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 04 November 2024 at around 11:43 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgys. 1 and 2, Pasay City. The fire was declared out at around 1:25 PM.

A total of **128 families** or **410 persons** are affected in **2 barangays** in **Pasay City** (see Annex A).

### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **128 families** or **410 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Andres Bonifacio Elementary School evacuation center** in **Pasay City** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

**25 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Pasay City** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱341,900.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families by **DSWD** (see Annex D).
