

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Sampaloc, Manila City as of 27 November 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 November 2024 at around 6:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 489 and Brgy. 490, Sampaloc, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 8:12 PM.

A total of **57 families** or **136 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **57 families** or **136 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. 490 Barangay Hall** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **11 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex C).
