

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Bukidnon

as of 12 November 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 15 October 2024, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day, several municipalities in the province of Bukidnon experienced incidents of flooding due to the continuous rains brought by localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **85 families** or **316 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **seven (7) families** or **28 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Kahusayan Covered Court** in **Brgy. Kahusayan, Kitaotao, Bukidnon** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **36 houses** were damaged; of which, **16** are **totally damaged** and **20** are **partially damaged** in **Bukidnon** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱235,575.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Units (LGUs)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
