



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Capiz

as of 07 November 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 04 November 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 4:00 AM, several barangays in the municipalities of Jamindan and Mambusao in Capiz experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,935 families** or **7,108 persons** are affected in **26 barangays** in **Capiz** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of five (5) families or 17 persons sought temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Capiz (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **23 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population A total of 13 families or 40 persons were displaced in Capiz (see Annex D).

- 89,682 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 9,422 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 80,260 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 69,865 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱264.28 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
