



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Davao Region

as of 30 November 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 24 November 2024 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms caused by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Caraga and Davao Region.

On the same day, several barangays in the municipality of Malita, Davao Occidental experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ. At around 7:00 PM, the municipality of Monkayo, Davao De Oro also experienced flooding and landslides due to heavy rains brought by the ITCZ

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **83 families** or **310 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **28 families** or **98 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Tical Covered Court** in **Malita**, **Davao Occidental** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **12 families** or **42 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **40 families** or **140 persons** were displaced in **Davao Region** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were partially damaged in Malita, Davao Occidental (see Annex E).
