





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City

as of 30 November 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 November 2024 at around 9:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at 1697 LRC, 919 Quezon Boulevard in Brgy. 310, Zone 31, Santa Cruz, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:25 AM on 28 November 2024.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 516 families or 1,468 persons are affected in Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 516 families or 1,468 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Bascom Covered Court in Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 419 houses were damaged; of which, 415 are totally damaged and four (4) are partially damaged in Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City (see Annex C).

28 November 2024	 DSWD FO NCR through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) continuously coordinates with the Local Government Unit of Manila City to provide resource augmentation and technical assistance needed for the families affected by the fire incident. DSWD FO NCR continuously coordinated with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Manila City through its Manila Department of Social Welfare for significant updates and any requests for augmentation.
28 November 2024	 DSWD FO NCR through its DRMD conducted Rapid Disaster Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) in the affected barangay. DSWD FO NCR ensured the availability of FNIs for possible augmentation.


