

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City as of 03 November 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 01 November 2024 at around 7:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Labasan St., Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 9:00 AM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **eight (8) families** or **21 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **seven (7) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Kayang Extension Day Care Center** in **Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **five (5) families** or **14 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **eight (8) families** or **21 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City** (see Annex E).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Kayang Extension, Baguio City** (see Annex F).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱66,323.14** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱38,323.14** from **DSWD** and **₱28,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
