

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental as of 21 November 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 November 2024 at around 2:16 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 3, San Lazaro, Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 3:36 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **206 families** or **814 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **90 families** or **450 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **152 houses** were damaged; of which, **122** are **totally damaged** and **30** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex C).
