I. Situation Overview

On 20 October 2024, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1, Brgy. Proper Langcagan, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental.

A total of five (5) families or 16 persons are affected in Brgy. Proper Langcangan, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **five (5) families** or **16 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of Five (5) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Proper Langcangan, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P51,810.40** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P41,810.40** from **DSWD** and **P10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).
