



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incident in Capiz

as of 12 November 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 04 November 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 4:00 AM, several barangays in the municipalities of Jamindan, Mambusao and Sigma in Capiz experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,473 families** or **9,260 persons** are affected in **30 barangays** in **Capiz** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of five (5) families or 17 persons sought temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Capiz (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **23 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **13 families** or **40 persons** were displaced in **Capiz** (see Annex D).
