

# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao

as of 12 December 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 24 November 2024, several barangays in the municipality of Malita, Davao Occidental experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ. At around 7:00 PM, the municipality of Monkayo, Davao De Oro also experienced flooding and landslides due to heavy rains brought by the ITCZ.

On 25 November 2024, a flooding incident was experienced in Brgy. Calagdaan, Cantillan while a landslide incident in Brgy. Tambis, Barobo in Surigao del Sur.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **87 families** or **332 persons** are affected in **seven (7) barangays** in **Regions XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **28 families** or **98 persons** sought temporary shelter shelter at the **Brgy**. **Tical Covered Court** in **Malita**, **Davao Occidental** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **18 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are three (3) families or 18 persons still displaced in Barobo, Surigao del Sur (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were partially damaged in Regions XI and Caraga (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱4,213.33 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱3,213.33 from DSWD and ₱1,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).

- ₱45.42 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5.62 million available at DSWD FOs XI and Caraga.
- ₱42 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the affected families.

## 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 256,518 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 117,548 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 138,970 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 302,115 FFPs available at DSWD FOs XI and Caraga.
- 946,710 FFPs available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the affected families.
- ₱891.26 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, DSWD FO XI and Caraga warehouses.
