

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City as of 06 December 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 27 November 2024 at around 9:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at 1697 LRC, 919 Quezon Boulevard in Brgy. 310, Zone 31, Santa Cruz, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:25 AM on 28 November 2024.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **522 families** or **1,485 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **522 families** or **1,485 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Bascom Covered Court** in **Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **419 houses** were damaged; of which, **415** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱672,336.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
