

## **DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Pedro, Molo, Iloilo City**

as of 27 November 2024, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 21 November 2024 at around 12:12 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Pedro, Molo, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 2:05 PM.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **101 families** or **321 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Pedro, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **78 families** or **243 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Molo 1 Elementary School** in **Brgy. San Pedro, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **23 families** or **78 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **101 families** or **321 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. San Pedro, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex F).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **63 houses** were damaged; of which, **56** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Pedro, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex G).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱920,766.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱429,780** from **DSWD** and **₱490,986.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex H).
