

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao

as of 13 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 November 2024, several barangays in the municipality of Malita, Davao Occidental experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ. At around 7:00 PM, the municipality of Monkayo, Davao De Oro also experienced flooding and landslides due to heavy rains brought by the ITCZ.

On 25 November 2024, a flooding incident was experienced in Brgy. Calagdaan, Cantillan while a landslide incident in Brgy. Tambis, Barobo in Surigao del Sur.

On 29 November 2024, a flooding incident due to heavy rains brought by the ITCZ was also experienced in Brgy. Sta. Isabel, Sta. Filomena and Turno, Dipolog City.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **695 families** or **3,372 persons** are affected in **10 barangays** in **Regions IX**, **XI** and **Caraga** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **28 families** or **98 persons** sought temporary shelter shelter at the **Brgy. Tical Covered Court** in **Malita, Davao Occidental** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **611 families** or **3,058 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 611 families or 3,058 persons still displaced in Barobo, Surigao del Sur and Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were partially damaged in Regions XI and Caraga (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}4,213.33\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}3,213.33\$ from \$\mathbb{D}\$SWD and \$\mathbb{P}1,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱45.42 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱7.88 million available at DSWD FOs IX, XI and Caraga.
- ₱39 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the affected families.

- 256,518 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 107,548 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 148,970 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 363,655 FFPs available at DSWD FOs IX, XI and Caraga.
- 881,662 FFPs available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the affected families.
