

## **DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** as of 30 November 2024, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 24 November 2024 at around 8:02 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1, 2 and 3, Isla Puting Bato, Brgy 20, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 2:07 PM.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **2,114 families** or **6,957 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **1,800 families** or **5,701 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Delpa Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **314 families** or **1,256 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **2,114 families** or **6,957 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **1,762 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱2,973,760.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
