





DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City

as of 30 November 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 November 2024 at around 8:02 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1, 2 and 3, Isla Puting Bato, Brgy 20, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 2:07 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,114 families** or **6,957 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,800 families or 5,701 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the **Delpan Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. 20**, **Tondo**, **Manila City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **314 families** or **1,256 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 2,114 families or 6,957 persons still displaced in Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 1,762 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱2,973,760.00 worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
