I. Situation Overview

On 16 November 2024, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Maligaya, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

A total of **11 families** or **20 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Maligaya, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P32,323.35** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
