

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Capiz

28 January 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

Issued on 04 November 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 4:00 AM, several barangays in the municipalities of Jamindan, Mambusao and Sigma in Capiz experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **5,839 families** or **21,807 persons** were affected in **39 barangays** in **Capiz** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **11 families** or **43 persons** sought temporary shelter in **five (5) evacuation centers** in **Capiz** (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **nine (9) families** or **27 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **20 families** or **70 persons** were displaced in **Capiz** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **partially damaged** in **Capiz** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex F).
