





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Kanlaon Volcano Eruption

09 January 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 03 June 2024 at 8 PM, Alert Level 2 was raised for Kanlaon Volcano after a moderately explosive eruption occurred at the summit crater. Subsequent observations were recorded over the Kanlaon Volcano throughout June, July, August, and September noting heightened seismic activity, ground deformation, and elevated sulfur dioxide emissions.

The public was urged to remain vigilant and refrain from entering the four-kilometerradius Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) to mitigate risks associated with volcanic hazards, including pyroclastic flows and rockfalls. In the event of ash fall, individuals should have protected their respiratory health by using damp cloths or dust masks.

Civil aviation authorities were advised to instruct pilots to avoid the vicinity of the volcano due to the potential dangers posed by ash and projectiles. Additionally, communities near river systems on the southern and western slopes should have taken precautions in anticipation of heavy rainfall, particularly those that have previously experienced lahars or muddy flows.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **17,371 families** or **57,563 persons** were affected in **23 barangays** in **Regions VI** and **VII** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **2,186 families** or **7,015 persons** sought temporary shelter in **33 evacuation centers** in **Regions VI** and **VII** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **176 families** or **631 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **2,362 families** or **7,646 persons** were displaced in **Regions VI** and **VII** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **2,680 houses** were **partially damaged** in **La Castellana**, **Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).







## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱55,311,417.67 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱38,511,254.28 from DSWD, ₱4,674,678.97 from the Local Government Units (LGUs), ₱2,491,000.00 from Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), and ₱9,634,484.92 from other Partners (see Annex F).
