





# **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on Kanlaon Volcano Eruption**

as of 10 December 2024, 6AM


## I. Situation Overview

- As of 10 December 2024, at 12:00 AM, alert level was raised from Alert Level 2 (increasing unrest) to Alert Level 3 (magmatic unrest) over Kanlaon Volcano, which means a magmatic eruption has begun that may progress to further explosive eruptions. All local government units are advised to evacuate the 6-km radius from the summit of the volcano and must be prepared for additional evacuation if activity warrants.
- An explosive eruption occurred at the summit vent of Kanlaon Volcano at 3:03 PM on 09 December 2024. The eruption produced a voluminous plume that rapidly rose to 3,000 meters above the vent and drifted west-southwest. Pyroclastic density currents or PDCs descended the slopes on the general southeastern edifice based on IP and thermal camera monitors.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 2,009 families or 6,553 persons are affected in 14 barangays in Regions VI and VII (see Annex A).





## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,992 families or 6,491 persons currently taking temporary shelter in 13 evacuation centers in Regions VI and VII (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **17 families** or **62 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

## c. Total Displaced Population

There are 2,009 families or 6,553 persons still displaced in Regions VI and VII (see Annex D).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱628,300.00 worth of assistance from DSWD was provided to the affected families (see Annex E).
