

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on Kanlaon Volcano Eruption

as of 10 December 2024, 6AM

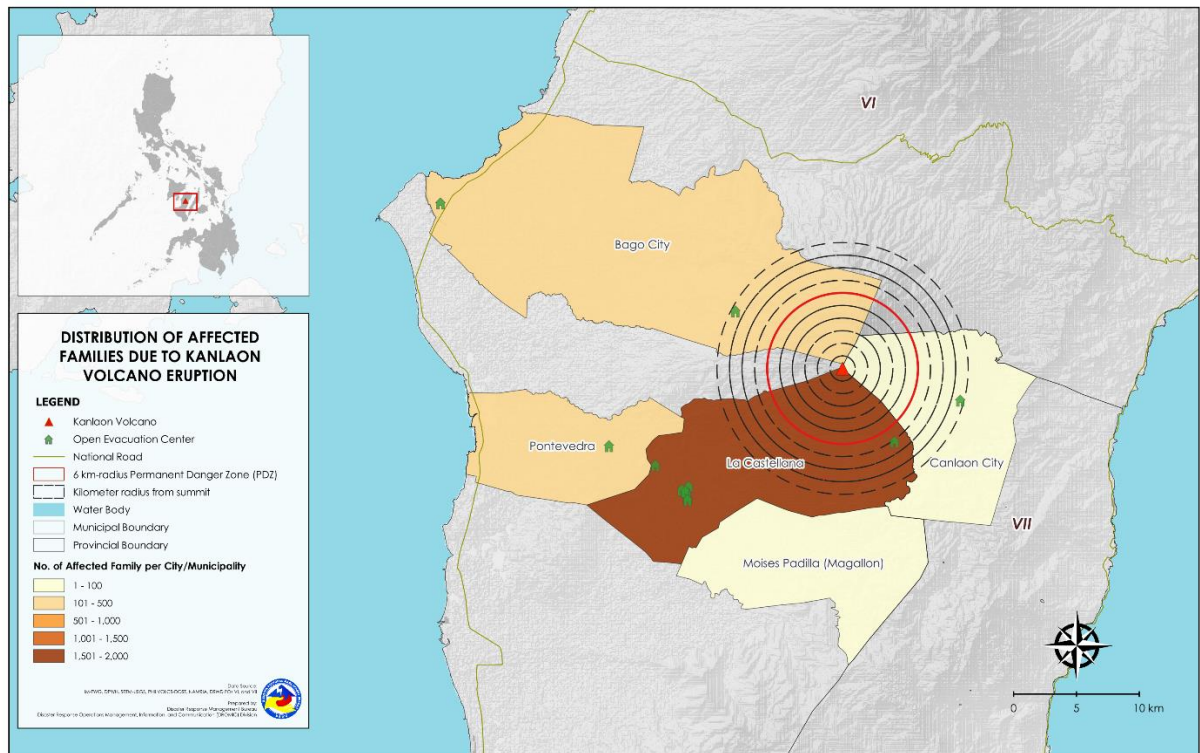
I. Situation Overview

- As of **10 December 2024**, at **12:00 AM**, alert level was raised from Alert Level 2 (increasing unrest) to **Alert Level 3 (magmatic unrest)** over Kanlaon Volcano, which means a magmatic eruption has begun that may progress to further explosive eruptions. All local government units are advised to evacuate the 6-km radius from the summit of the volcano and must be prepared for additional evacuation if activity warrants.
- An explosive eruption occurred at the summit vent of Kanlaon Volcano at 3:03 PM on 09 December 2024. The eruption produced a voluminous plume that rapidly rose to 3,000 meters above the vent and drifted west-southwest. Pyroclastic density currents or PDCs descended the slopes on the general southeastern edifice based on IP and thermal camera monitors.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,009 families** or **6,553 persons** are affected in **14 barangays** in **Regions VI and VII** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,992 families** or **6,491 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **13 evacuation centers** in **Regions VI** and **VII** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **17 families** or **62 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **2,009 families** or **6,553 persons** still displaced in **Regions VI** and **VII** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱628,300.00** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex E).
