

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of African Swine Fever in Brgy. San Vicente, San Miguel, Bohol

as of 09 December 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 22 November 2024, confirmed cases of African Swine Fever (ASF) were reported in Brgy. San Vicente, San Miguel, Bohol. ASF is a highly contagious viral disease of domestic and wild pigs, whose mortality rate can reach 100%. It is not a danger to human health, but it has devastating effects on pig populations and the farming economy. The virus is highly resistant to the environment, meaning that it can survive on clothes, boots, wheels, and other materials.
