

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Mindanao as of 28 December 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 December 2024, several barangays in the municipality of Malita and Don Marcelino, Davao Occidental experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the ITCZ.

On 26 December 2024, a flash flood incident was experienced in several barangays in General Santos City, Alabel and Glan, Sarangani due to heavy rains caused by the effects of ITCZ.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,742 families** or **11,084 persons** are affected in **16 barangays** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **823 families** or **3,534 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **seven (7) evacuation centers** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **30 families** or **133 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **853 families** or **3,667 persons** still displaced in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **120 houses** were damaged; of which, **74** are **totally damaged** and **46** are **partially damaged** in **Regions XI** and **XII** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱541,070.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
