

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorm in Brgy. Riverside, Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte

as of 04 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 November 2024, heavy waves and strong winds due to Localized Thunderstorms were experienced in Brgy. Riverside, Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **two (2) families** or **eight (8) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Riverside, Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte**. (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Riverside, Kolambugan, Lanao del Norte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱22,258.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱17,258.00** from **DSWD** and **₱5,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
