

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 218, Tondo, Manila City

as of 18 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 December 2024 at around 5:44 PM, a fire incident occurred at New Antipolo St., Brgy. 218, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 7:07 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) NCR

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **91 families** or **297 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 218, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **91 families** or **297 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. 218, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **30 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 218, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
