





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 03, Rosario, Northern Samar

as of 02 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 October 2024 at around 6:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Aguinaldo St., Brgy. 03 (San Lorenzo), Rosario, Northern Samar. The fire was declared out at around 6:51 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or three (3) persons are affected in Brgy. 03 (San Lorenzo), Rosario, Northern Samar (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Outside Evacuation Center

One family or three (3) persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One house was totally damaged in Brgy. 03 (San Lorenzo), Rosario, Northern Samar (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P5,672.50** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex D).
