I. Situation Overview

On 04 December 2024 at around 6:58 AM, a fire incident occurred at Tenorio St., Brgy. 774, San Andres Bukid, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 9:08 AM.

A total of **136 families** or **491 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 774, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **136 families** or **491 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. 774, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **63 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 774, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱554,415.33** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex D).
