

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 774, San Andres Bukid, Manila City

as of 18 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 December 2024 at around 6:58 AM, a fire incident occurred at Tenorio St., Brgy. 774, San Andres Bukid, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 9:08 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 136 families or 491 persons are affected in Brgy. 774, San Andres Bukid, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 136 families or 491 persons currently taking temporary shelter in one (1) evacuation center in Brgy. 774, San Andres Bukid, Manila City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 63 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 774, San Andres Bukid, Manila City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P554,415.33** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex D).
