

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 80 (Marasbaras), Tacloban City, Leyte

as of 03 December 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 November 2024 at around 10:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy.80 (Marasbaras), Tacloban City, Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **25 families** or **68 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 80 (Marasbaras), Tacloban City, Leyte**. (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **24 families** or **67 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. 80 Barangay Hall** in **Tacloban City, Leyte** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **one (1) person** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **25 families** or **68 persons** displaced in **Brgy. 80 (Marasbaras), Tacloban City, Leyte** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were totally damaged in **Brgy. 80 (Marasbaras), Tacloban City, Leyte** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱484,545.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱400,545.00** from **DSWD** and **₱84,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
