I. Situation Overview

On 04 December 2024 around 2:24 AM, a fire incident occurred at 17G Lions Road, Brgy. Barangka Ilaya, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 4:22 AM.

A total of **105 families** or **397 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Barangka Ilaya, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

There are **105 families** or **397 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Barangka Ilaya Covered Court** in **Brgy. Barangka Ilaya, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

A total of **59 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Barangka Ilaya, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex C).
