

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya, Kawit, Cavite

as of 17 December 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 10 December 2024 at around 5:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya, Kawit, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 8:00 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **100 families** or **415 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya**, **Kawit, Cavite** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **100 families** or **415 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Zapote 1 Covered Court** in **Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya, Kawit, Cavite** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **100 houses** were damaged; of which, **65** are **totally damaged** and **35** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya**, **Kawit**, **Cavite** (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,200,118.84 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱570,796.00 from DSWD and ₱581,322.84 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
