

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya, Kawit, Cavite

as of 17 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 December 2024 at around 5:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya, Kawit, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 8:00 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **100 families** or **415 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya, Kawit, Cavite** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **100 families** or **415 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Zapote 1 Covered Court** in **Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya, Kawit, Cavite** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **100 houses** were damaged; of which, **65** are **totally damaged** and **35** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Binakayan-Aplaya, Kawit, Cavite** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,200,118.84** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱570,796.00** from **DSWD** and **₱581,322.84** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
