I. Situation Overview

On 07 December 2024 at around 2:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Buenavista, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar. The fire was declared out at around 4:00 PM.

One (1) family or six (6) persons are affected in Brgy. Buenavista, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar (see Annex A).

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or six (6) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Buenavista, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P8,080.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
