

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cansojong, City of Talisay, Cebu

as of 08 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 November 2024 at around 10:38 AM, a fire incident occurred at Base St., Brgy. Cansojong, City of Talisay, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 11:29 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **44 families** or **168 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cansojong, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **44 families** or **168 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Cansojong Barangay Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Cansojong, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **28 houses** were damaged; of which, **26** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Cansojong, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱638,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱488,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱150,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
