I. Situation Overview

On 22 November 2024 at around 2:23 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sanciangco Street, Brgy. Catmon, Malabon City. The fire was declared out at around 4:10 PM.

A total of **21 families** or **67 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Catmon, Malabon City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **21 families** or **67 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Catmon Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. Catmon, Malabon City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **five (5) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Catmon, Malabon City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱33,751.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
