

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Maunlad, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan as of 09 December 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 November 2024 at around 4:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Daisy, Brgy. Maunlad, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **61 families** or **225 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Maunlad, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **33 families** or **138 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in the **Barangay Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Maunlad, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **28 families** or **87 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **61 families** or **225 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Maunlad, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **61 houses** were damaged; of which, **23** are **totally damaged** and **38** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Maunlad, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,294,709.01** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱866,903.85** from **DSWD** and **₱427,805.16** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
