A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Palua, Mangaldan, Pangasinan (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}20,000.00\$ worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex C).
