

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Patag, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 21 December 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 November 2024 at around 1:25 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 3, Brgy. Patag, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 2:50 PM.

A total of 24 families or 79 persons are affected in Brgy. Patag, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **20 families** or **71 persons** that took temporary shelter in **Brgy. Patag** Covered Court in Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 10 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Patag, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}317,596.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}210,936.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}106,660.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
