

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Aurora, Zamboanga del Sur

as of 22 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 December 2024 at around 12:47 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Aurora, Zamboanga del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 1:35 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of eight (8) families or 27 persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion, Aurora, Zamboanga del Sur (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **eight (8) families** or **27 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of five (5) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Aurora, Zamboanga del Sur (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P28,520.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
