

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, City of Urdaneta, Pangasinan

as of 13 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 December 2024 at around 4:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Estrada St., Brgy. Poblacion, City of Urdaneta, Pangasinan. The fire was declared out at around 8:00 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 38 families or 139 persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion, City of Urdaneta, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 38 families or 139 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. Poblacion, City of Urdaneta, Pangasinan (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 15 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, City of Urdaneta, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}371,793.50\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}341,393.50\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}30,400.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
