

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Puguis, La Trinidad, Benguet

as of 09 December 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 November 2024 at around 1:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Puguis Proper, Brgy. Puguis, La Trinidad, Benguet. The fire was declared out at around 5:13 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **48 families** or **134 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Puguis, La Trinidad, Benguet** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **22 families** or **59 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **seven (7) houses** were damaged; of which, **four (4)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Puguis, La Trinidad, Benguet** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱500,334.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱246,829.60** from **DSWD**, **₱26,505.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, and **₱227,000.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex D).
